- 6 people in recovery engage in daily substance-free activities
- 3 homeless families have a safe place to stay while they become financially stable.
- 13 low-income people receive food for a month

\$20 A MONTH

- 10 students get extra help from a senior in their classrooms
- 19 kids receive a healthy lunch & play games during the summer break
- a child who is abused or neglected has an advocate as they navigate court proceedings

\$50 A MONTH

- 6 women & children have safety & stability when fleeing abuse
- 20 students receive homework help after school
- 2 children with special needs receive respite care
- 200 2nd-graders are given a book & challenged to read

\$100 A MONTH

- a child with special needs receives extra support to prepare him to succeed when he starts school
- 7 homeless teens have a safe place to study, do laundry & enjoy a warm meal
